

thyssenkrupp wins major service order in Germany for nearly 20,000 automatic doors of the Federal Employment Agency

- Full service for automatic doors in the agency's buildings
- A four-year contract valued at over two million euros
- Biggest door-related order of its kind for the German company

The Federal Employment Agency in Germany has chosen thyssenkrupp Elevator to service a total of 19,687 of its automatic doors, fire doors, hold-open mechanisms and gate systems for a period of four years; this contract represents the biggest door-related order ever received by thyssenkrupp in Germany.
