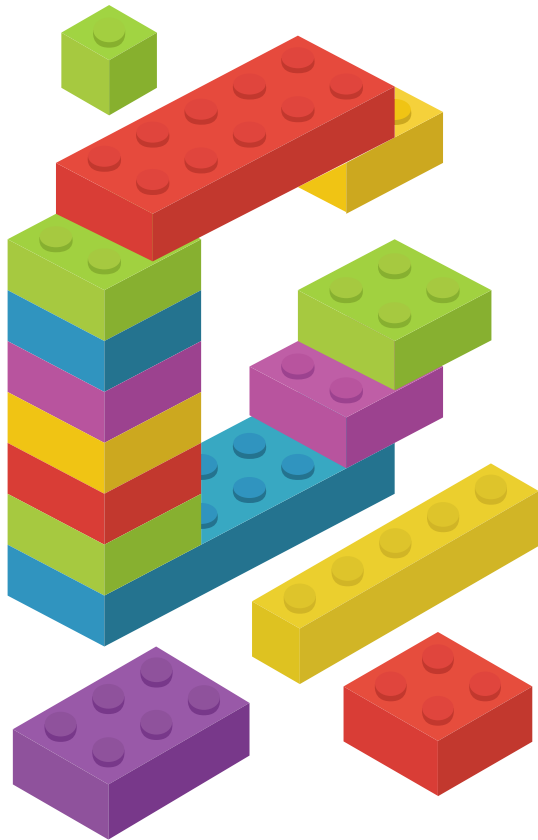

GET OUT THE **BRICKS!**



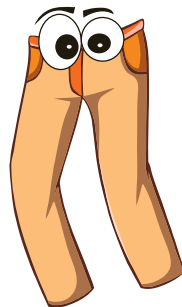
Last month, we shared a video about how to build an elevator using materials at home. This month, try building an elevator using building bricks!

Did you know that some people have a fear of riding in elevators? It's called **Elevatophobia**. To help with a relaxing ride, elevators can be built with digital screens (like TVs) to show videos or just have music playing. And even if you love riding elevators having entertainment while you ride is fun too!



Building owners can choose what they want to show on the digital screens using APIs (Application Programming Interfaces). APIs translate 'computer speak' so two systems like an elevator screen and a building can talk to each other.
