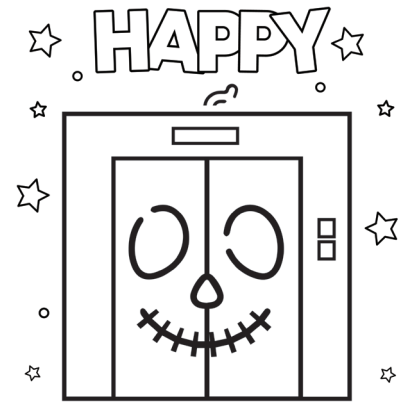

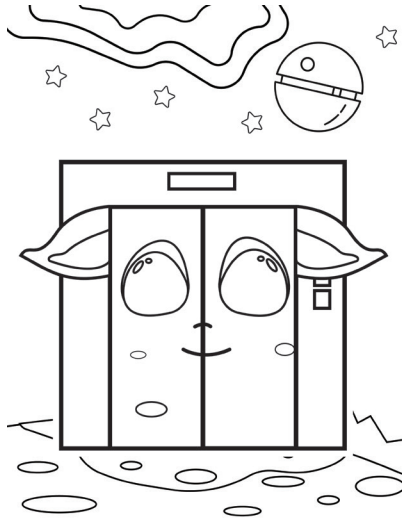
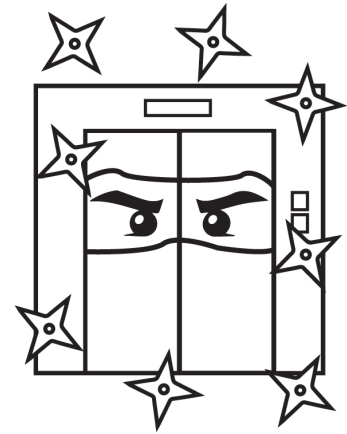
Everyone should be able to wear a Halloween costume - **EVEN AN ELEVATOR!**

We picked some costumes, but we need help choosing the colors. Pick your favorite (or all of them!) and have fun coloring them in.

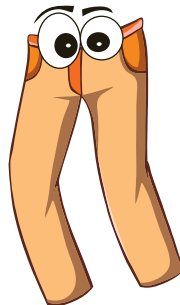

DO ELEVATORS FALL UP OR DOWN?

Elevators ONLY “fall” when they’re being tested. It is called a **drop-load test**. When people ride them, safety equipment **stops** the elevator if it starts to move too quickly.



DID YOU KNOW...

Elevators actually fall up. There is a stack of **counterweights** that move down while the cab moves or “falls” up.
