

SAFETY RIDING TIPS

FOR ELEVATORS



Let others exit before boarding

Enter and exit quickly

Use the "Door Open" button if people need to enter after you

Watch your step when entering or exiting - it might not be completely level with the floor

Use the alarm, help button, telephone or intercom in case of emergency

Wait for help to arrive if you are stuck

Never attempt to stop closing doors with your hands, feet or body

Never use in case of fire - take the stairs

Never try and climb out of a stalled elevator or try to pry open the doors





Make SURE shoelaces are tied

Stand and face forward

Hold an adult's hand and the handrail

Grab the handrail when you step on and off

Keep your hands, feet and clothing away from the sides

> Exit quickly so others can get off safely

Never walk or run

Never let your feet slide off the end

Never try and ride IN the wrong direction

Escalators are not meant to move wheelchairs, strollers or carts
